

# Chris Swinhart

## 2023 MEMORIAL GOLF SCHOLARSHIP



Chris Swinhart served as the Head Golf Professional at Thorncreek Golf Course in Thornton from 2014 until his unexpected death in November of 2020 while on a hunting trip in Kansas with friends. Before his employment with Thorncreek, he worked for 14 years in the same role at Legacy Ridge Golf Course in Westminster.

Chris was instrumental in growing the game of golf in Colorado and especially at Thorncreek. His greatest passion at work was spending time coaching young children.

In his honor, we present the *Chris Swinhart Memorial Scholarship*. This annual scholarship will be awarded to five (5) select Thornton youth who meet the requirements below and submit a short essay about his or her desire to learn the game of golf.

Scholarship winners will receive complimentary access to our 2023 Thorncreek Junior Golf Camp (\$200 value) and their own personal set of U.S. Kids Golf Clubs (\$250 value).

## Eligibility and Requirements

**QUALIFICATIONS** Applicants must be a Thornton resident between the ages of 5-15 years old on June 1, 2023. Proof of Thornton residency and proof that you qualify for any of the following programs must be provided with your application:

- ▶ Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP)
- ▶ Medicaid
- ▶ Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
- ▶ Women, Infants and Children (WIC)
- ▶ Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF)

**SCHOLARSHIPS** Five scholarships will be awarded annually to the most qualified youth as determined by a selection committee comprised of one representative from Thorncreek's Men's, Women's and Senior golf leagues.

**DEADLINE** Entries must be received at Thorncreek Golf Course by April 1, 2023.

**SELECTIONS** Winners will be contacted no later than April 15, 2023. Results will be posted on Thorncreek's website at [thorncreekgc.com](http://thorncreekgc.com).
